RPC Content: You have licensed the right to use certain RPC Content according to the terms of this License. 1. <u>License</u>. ArchVision, Inc. ("ArchVision") grants you a nonexclusive, nontransferable license to use one copy of this program (the "ArchVision Software") and its manual and other accompanying printed material and "online" or electronic documentation ("Documentation") with equipment owned by you or under your control, according to the terms and conditions of this License. The ArchVision Software accompanying this License, whether downloaded from ArchVision's web site or provided on disk, in read only memory, on any other media or in any other form, is licensed, not sold, to You by ArchVision, Inc. and/or its subsidiaries, if any, (collectively "ArchVision"). You own the media on which the ArchVision Software is recorded, but ArchVision retains title to the ArchVision Software. The ArchVision Software and any copies made and/or distributed under this License are subject to this License.

Upgrades: If this software is labeled as an upgrade ("New Version") to software previously licensed to you ("Previous Version"), you must destroy the original and all copies of the Previous Version, including any copies resident on your hard disk drive which accompanied the software previously licensed to you, within 10 days of acquiring the New Version. You may under no circumstances operate the New Version and Previous Version concurrently on different computers. If requested by ArchVision, you agree to show satisfactory proof that the Previous Version and all copies thereof have been destroyed. - 2. <u>License Term.</u> Subject to the terms and conditions of this License, the License shall continue until terminated, unless the software is designated as a fixed-term license, a beta testing license, a limited duration license, or a rental license. In such case the term of the license shall be the limited term so designated. Use of this after the expiration of any fixed-term or limited duration, as well as any use beyond that expressly permitted by this license or any attempt to defeat the disabling function, may constitute copyright infringement and/or a violation of intellectual property laws.
- 3. <u>Permitted Uses and Restrictions</u>. Under the terms of this License, you may install and use the ArchVision Software on a single computer at a time.
